ORIGIN

May 2, 2006 In Camera session of Halifax Regional Council.

BACKGROUND

Staff have had several meetings, including a meeting on site, to identify and resolve the issues surrounding the above property and adjacent street Right-of-Way to the Arm.

DISCUSSION

Staff has identified the following as action items and timing:

- 1. Meeting/discussion with owners & agents of the property on Oakland Road regarding sewer easement, public pathway and wharf, mid August, subject to participant availability
- 2. Development of detailed conceptual design, pathway & wharf improvements, recognizing the boundary, easement and other issues that came to light in the legal review of the properties.
- 3. Schedule an appropriate community consultation information meeting.
- 4. Report to Regional Council end of September.
- 5. Council approval
- 6. On-going appropriate changes to the Oakland Road wharf property zoning (e.g., parkland vs. Right-of-Way).
