ORIGIN

The Approved 2007/08 Capital Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council:

- 1. approve the recovery of Local Improvement Charges for the new concrete sidewalk on Eaglewood Drive Central Region by an area rate to the urban area of District 21.
- 2. award Tender No. 07-227, New Sidewalk, Eaglewood Drive Central Region to Dexter Construction Company Limited for a Total Tender Price of \$172,933.29 (net HST included) with funding from Capital Account No. CJU00785 New Sidewalks, as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

The approved 2007/08 Capital Budget includes funds for a new sidewalk on Eaglewood Drive from Peregrine Crescent to Golf Links Road.

DISCUSSION

Tenders were called on May 12, 2007 and closed on May 23, 2007. Bids were received from the following companies:

The scope of work for this tender generally consists of the installation of concrete sidewalk, adjustment to driveways, planting of trees, and associated reinstatement.

It is anticipated that work will commence within three weeks of the tender award and take six weeks to complete.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

The installation of a new concrete sidewalk is subject to Local Improvement Charges. At the request of Councillor Gary Martin, Local Improvement Charges will be based on a charge per foot of frontage and will be recovered by the levy of an area rate to the urban area of District 21. On April 25, 2006, Halifax Regional Council approved a blended actual costs approach in determining the rate of Local Improvement Charges. The rate will be set once the tenders have been completed and the final costs determined.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Based on the lowest tendered price of \$172,933.29, including net HST, funding is available in the Approved 2007/08 Capital Budget from Account No. CJU00785 - New Sidewalks. The budget availability has been approved by Financial Services.
