STAFF REPORT

ORIGIN

Approved HRM 2002/03 Capital Budget, Deadman's Island - Public Access Pathway Improvements (Account # CDG00305-\$80,000).

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that:

1. Council approve the award of Tender #02-P455 - Deadman's Island Public Access Pathway Improvements to TurfMasters Landscaping for materials and services specified at the unit prices quoted for a tender price of \$79,500.00 plus net HST, for a total project cost of \$84,611.06 from Capital Accounts CDG00305 and CCV00192 as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

Council appointed the Deadman's Island Committee to advise Council on the development of Deadman's Island as a International, National, Provincial and Municipal historic site. The committee has been working with staff to create public access to the Island, and at their January 15, 2002 meeting the Committee agreed to proceed with this project.

DISCUSSION

A tender for this project was advertised and closed on May 21, 2002. The following bids were received:
