

ORIGIN

Halifax Regional Council, December 4, 2001, item 11.2.1.

BACKGROUND

It was requested by Regional Council, based on a recommendation by North West Community Council, that the Traffic Authority seriously look at the issue of the Wardour Street/Dartmouth Road/North Street intersection, and that a traffic warrant for this intersection be redone.

DISCUSSION

A signal warrant analysis for this intersection will be performed and results reported to North West Community Council. Data will be collected during the summer counting program and the warrant calculation will be completed by September 15.
