SUBJECT: Award of Unit Price Tender No. 02-258, Sewer Lining - West and East

Regions

ORIGIN

Approved 2000/01 and 2002/03 Capital Budgets.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Council award Tender No. 02-258, Sewer Lining - West and East Regions to Inliner Canada Inc. for materials and services listed at the unit prices quoted for a Tender Price of \$376,005, plus net HST for a total of \$400,179 from Account No.'s: CGU00025, Pleasant Street (Atlantic to Irving); CGU00322, Stairs Street, Dartmouth - Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation (Lining); CGU00119, Hydrostone Lanes, Halifax - Sewer Rehabilitation (Lining); CGU00320, Oakland Road (Robie to Beaufort), Halifax - Sewer Rehabilitation (Lining) and CGU00329, Ashgrove Avenue, Cole Harbour - Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation (Lining), with funding authorized as per the Budget Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

The 2000/01 and 2002/03 Approved Capital Budgets include funds to reline portions of combined and sanitary sewers within the Halifax Regional Municipality. These sections of sewer have various forms of structural defects such as pipe cracking, pipe collapse, offset joints, protruding tree roots and infiltration. The new lining will improve the structural integrity and function of the sewer pipe.

DISCUSSION

Tenders were called on June 1, 2002 and closed on June 20, 2002. The following bids, exclusive of taxes, were received:

The scope of work for this tender generally consists of the rehabilitation of pipe by installation of a liner at the locations listed below:

Pleasant Street	(Atlantic St. to Irving St.)
Stairs Street	(Windmill Rd. to Bedford St.)
Hydrostone Lanes (2)	(Isleville St. to Novalea Dr.)
- between Stairs Place and Stanley Place	
- between Columbus Place and Merkel Place	
Oakland Road	(Robie St. to Beaufort Ave.)
Ashgrove Avenue	(Colby Dr. to Addison Pl.)

It is anticipated that work will commence within three weeks of the tender award.

This is a **UNIT PRICE** contract and the cost will be dependant upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

There are no Local Improvement Charges associated with this work.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Based on the lowest tendered price of \$376,005 plus net HST for a total of \$400,179 funding is available in the 2000/01 and 2002/03 Approved Capital Budgets under the Account No.'s listed below. The budget availability has been approved by Financial Services.
