## INFORMATION REPORT

#### **ORIGIN**

Halifax Regional Council meeting of February 4, 2003, Item 8.2.2.

## **BACKGROUND**

At the February 4, 2003 Halifax Regional Council meeting, Councillor Johns served a petition from the residents of Smokey Court expressing concern regarding the condition of their street.

#### **DISCUSSION**

Smokey Court is a local residential street in Lower Sackville which runs from Smokey Drive. The petition requests that street repairs and new curbs be installed on Smokey Court. This street is classified as a paved street with asphalt curb. The SDI pavement rating is indicative of a street requiring upgraded treatment.

Currently Smokey Court has not been listed as a street to be upgraded in the 2003/04 Capital Budget. Staff will prepare an estimate for the cost of upgrading Smokey Court with new asphalt and concrete curb and gutter and include it for consideration, along with other similar projects, for consideration as part of HRM's normal Capital Budget process. In the interim, staff will refer any maintenance requirements to our Streets and Roads Department.
