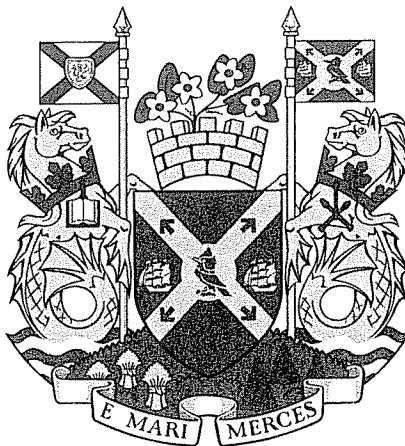

PROCLAMATION

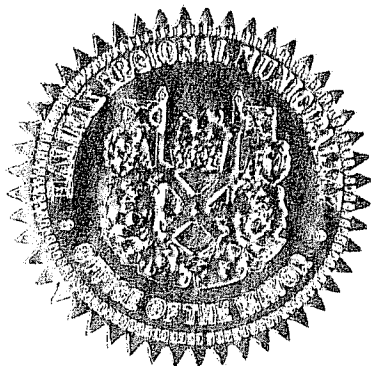
WHEREAS brain injuries are largely preventable and accidental occurrences, which can result in long term disabling symptoms for affected people; and


WHEREAS over 2,000 Nova Scotians each year suffer a brain injury; and
