SUBJECT: Vanessa Drive Street Condition

INFORMATION REPORT

ORIGIN

July 8, 2003 Halifax Regional Council, item 9.2.1.

BACKGROUND

Councillor Cunningham presented a petition by the residents of a portion of Vanessa Drive (Slayter Street to the dead-end), requesting the rehabilitation of the paved surface and curbing on their street.

DISCUSSION

This section of Vanessa Drive, with a surface distress index rating of 2.85, is not included in the current 3 year capital street rehabilitation listing, however the street will be re-evaluated in conjunction with this fall's capital budget preparations. In the interim, Public Works will undertake pavement repairs to improve the surface condition until such time as the street is fully rehabilitated.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Interim pavement surface repairs will be facilitated through approved 2003-04 operating funds.


