Subject: Expression of Interest for Purchase of Surplus Submarine for HRM

Request:

Please add Expression of Interest for Purchase of Surplus Submarine for HRM to the Council agenda for Tuesday, September 9, 2003.

Reason:

2004 will mark the 50th Anniversary of the First Royal Canadian Navy Submariners and the 25th Anniversary of the Submariners Association of Canada. I am requesting that the Mayor, on behalf of Council, write a letter to the Federal Government showing an expression of interest for the possible purchase of one of the retired submarines currently in Halifax Harbour. The submarine would be used for tourism purposes, perhaps as part of the new Dartmouth Heritage Museum. HRM could also approach the Waterfront Development Corporation, the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic and other interested parties to explore partnership possibilities. I would like a copy of this letter forwarded to the local Members of Parliament to solicit their support for this project.
