WHEREAS Thousands of women, mothers, sisters, daughters, wives, friends, neighbours and co-workers are affected by breast cancer every day; and


WHEREAS In Nova Scotia it is estimated that 700 women will be diagnosed this year with breast cancer in 2003 and it will take the life of 210 women;

WHEREAS One in eight women in Atlantic Canada will be diagnosed with breast cancer in their lifetime; and

WHEREAS The Canadian Breast Cancer Foundation CIBC Run for the Cure is hosting Think Pink Week to raise awareness of the Halifax CIBC Run for the Cure on October 5, 2003 - an annual event which raises awareness of breast cancer and funds for Atlantic research and community health projects;
