

SUBJECT: Petition for Concrete Curb and Gutter, Peddar's Way - East Region

INFORMATION REPORT

ORIGIN

Halifax Regional Council meeting of August 26, 2003, Item 9.2.

BACKGROUND

At the Halifax Regional Council meeting held on August 26, 2003, Councillor Cunningham served a petition from residents of Peddar's Way, between Bow Street and Oathill Crescent, requesting that the current concrete curb and gutter construction on Bow Street be extended to include replacement of asphalt curb on their street.

DISCUSSION

Peddar's Way is currently classified as a local street, although it is under consideration to be reclassified as a minor collector. Peddar's Way runs between Oathill Crescent and Manor Drive, which connects to Portland Street near the Penhorn Mall.

In recent years Manor Drive and the section of Peddar's Way between Manor Drive and Bow Street have had new concrete curb and gutter installed in conjunction with street paving. Presently new concrete curb and gutter is being installed on Bow Street under the HRM 2003/04 Capital Budget Paving Renewal program.

The petition presented to Council was signed by 11 residents from the section of Peddar's Way between Bow Street and Oathill who requested that the installation of concrete curb and gutter on Bow Street be extended to include replacement of the existing asphalt curbs on their section of Peddar's Way.

Staff estimates the cost to carry out the requested work would be approximately \$50,000. Since this project has not been approved by Council staff will include it with other projects for consideration in future Capital Budgets. In the interim, staff of Streets and Roads will be requested to review the condition of the existing asphalt curb for any maintenance work required.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

There are no budget implications at this time.
