

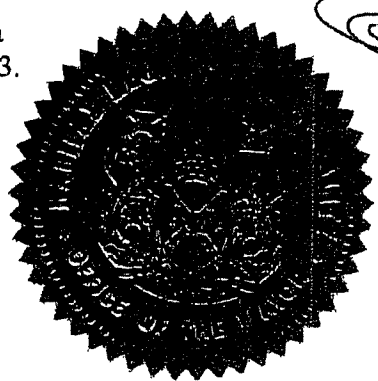
**WORLD TOWN PLANNING DAY
NOVEMBER 8, 2003**


PROCLAMATION
