ORIGIN

2003/04 Approved Capital Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that RFP 03-322 consultant design and engineering services, Beaver Bank Servicing, Phase 4D, 4E and Water Reservoir be awarded to the highest ranking proponent, CBCL Limited, for a cost of \$119,520, plus net HST for a total of \$127,204 with funding from Capital Account No.CGU00385, Beaver Bank Servicing, Phase 4D as per the Budget Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

The Halifax Regional Municipality in cooperation with the Federal and Provincial Governments under the Canada-Nova Scotia Infrastructure Program have provided funding to construct sanitary sewer, storm sewer and water distribution systems in the Beaver Bank Area. The design work of phases 4D, 4E and the water reservoir requires the services of consultant. The purpose of this report is to award the design work to a consultant.

DISCUSSION

Terms of Reference outlining the scope of work were prepared and a Request for Proposals was advertised and closed on October 17, 2003. Five (5) proposals were received from the following:

- 1. AMEC E&C Services Limited
- 2. CBCL Limited
- 3. Dillon Consulting
- 4. O'Halloran Campbell Consultants Limited
- 5. Terrain Group Inc.

The consultant evaluation process took place on October 30, 2003. The evaluation team consisted of staff from Design Services (PW&T), Halifax Regional Water Commission (HRWC), and Procurement (Financial Services). The criteria used for the evaluation of the proposals included: project team, firm's experience on similar works and performance on past HRM projects, understanding of the scope of works and methodology to complete the works, considerations of options, project schedule and fees, as well as overall proposal quality and compliance with the Terms of Reference.

The final scoring for each firm is as follows:
