



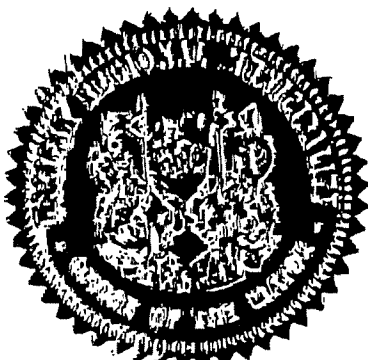
**NOVA SCOTIA CRIME STOPPERS MONTH
