



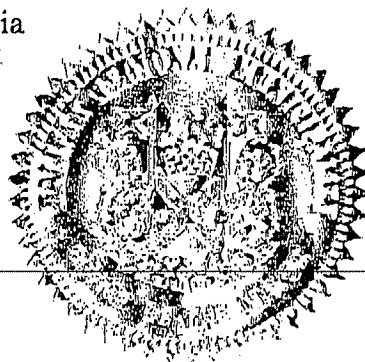
**WEGENER'S GRANULOMATOSIS AWARENESS WEEK
